

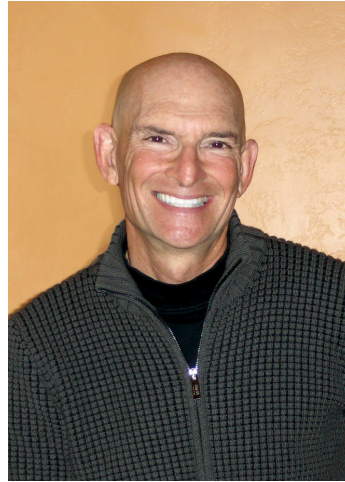

- 10:30 - 12:15: Phase I strategies to energize success and to avoid energizing negativity in light of the issues and challenges
- 1:15 - 2:45: Process morning and do experiential applications. (Q & A, discussion of earlier concepts, clinical examples).
- 3:00 - 4:30: Discussion and working through Phase I obstacles in treatment and education. (Clinical case studies related to issues when clients resist in various ways).
